Living to the rhythm of nature

Choroní is a place that invites you to unwind. Here, life revolves around the rhythms of nature: in the morning, the village wakes up to the sound of birdsong and the gentle sound of the sea. The surrounding cocoa plantations, which extend into the mountains, not only offer an insight into traditional farming, but also the opportunity to follow the chocolate's journey from tree to bar. A tasting of the locally produced chocolate is a must - a sensory experience that combines taste and culture.

Let your soul dangle by the turquoise blue sea

Just a few kilometers away is Puerto Colombia, a charming coastal village that delights with its Caribbean flair and the famous Playa Grande beach. The beach, lined with palm trees and overlooking the turquoise blue sea, is the perfect place to unwind. Here you can dig your feet into the warm sand, listen to the sound of the waves or simply soak up the sun. For those who want to get active, there are boat trips to hidden bays or snorkeling tours in the coral reefs.

Experience vibrant Afro-Caribbean culture

But Choroní and Puerto Colombia are more than just nature and relaxation. The Afro-Venezuelan culture gives the place a lively, vibrant feel. Especially during the festivals, when the sound of the traditional tambores (drums) fills the Malecón, the waterfront promenade. Entry and health

A passport valid for at least six months is all that is required for citizens of the European Union to enter Venezuela. Vaccinations are not mandatory – we recommend yellow fever – and malaria prophylaxis is not required for most trips. Physical requirements

If you opt for a longer guided hike (not included) such as the Ruta de Cacao, a 6-8 hour hike from Choroní to Chuao, you should be in normal physical condition. A certain degree of surefootedness is required for the river crossings, waterproof footwear and possibly a walking stick are advisable. You can also reach the cocoa village of Chuao (not included) by boat to the jetty. From there it is around three kilometers to the village. You can walk the route comfortably and with almost no incline, in the shade of the cocoa plantation, or order transportation in advance.

Facilities of the accommodation

The spacious rooms are equipped with a comfortable and large double bed, a private bathroom and some have a small kitchenette. The Posada has a pool in the middle of a palm-fringed garden. There is a boules court and table tennis tables.

The Posada is a member of the Circuito de Excelencia.

Food and drink

The Posada offers upscale Venezuelan cuisine, and as we are located on the coast, we mainly serve fish and seafood.
