Entry and health

A passport valid for at least six months is all that is required for citizens of the European Union to enter Venezuela. Vaccinations are not mandatory – we recommend yellow fever – and malaria prophylaxis is not required for most trips. Physical requirements

On the Costa Verde, you can go on various, mostly shorter hikes in the hinterland. You can also head for secluded beaches on fishing boats.

A certain amount of surefootedness is required when getting in and out of the boats and when crossing the river; waterproof footwear and possibly a walking stick are advisable.

Facilities of the accommodation

The rooms are equipped with a double bed and private bathroom. The Posada has a nice pool and a bar area.

Food and drink

The tour price includes a simple, typical local breakfast. The posada has a small restaurant. There are simple dining options in the nearby village.</p>
