Caracas in three days: culture, Cacao and culinary discoveries

Experience the vibrant capital of Venezuela, Caracas, on a journey that combines culture, history and culinary delights. This tour takes you through the many facets of the city - from historical treasures to culinary highlights and authentic encounters with the local culture.

Day 1: In the footsteps of Simón Bolívar

Start with a city tour of Caracas. We recognize he main highlights related to Simón Bolívar's life, a "caraqueño" with universal transcendence. Feel the spirit of independence in the Panteón Nacional, the national hall of fame. A stroll through the historic centre reveals colonial architecture and the hustle and bustle of the city.



A special highlight awaits you on the second day: a Cacao tour to Barlovento. Visit a traditional Cacao plantation and learn all about the cultivation and processing of the "brown gold". In a chocolate factory, you will experience how the finest chocolate is made from Cacao beans - a treat for all the senses. In the evening, return to Caracas and visit a typical bar where you can round off the day with local specialities.

Day 3: Cultural diversity in Caracas

The third day is all about cultural diversity. Explore the Barrio Petare, one of the largest and liveliest neighbourhoods in Caracas. Sample golfiaos, a local sweet, and get to know the daily life of the locals. A trip on the metro will take you to Chacao, a modern and lively neighbourhood where you can enjoy the urban flair on a walk.









Entry and health

For citizens of the European Union, only a passport valid for at least six months is required to enter Venezuela. Vaccinations are not mandatory and malaria prophylaxis is not required for most journeys.
